

Additional Licensing Requirements

- 1. The patient has the right to be free from all forms of abuse, harassment, discrimination or reprisal and exercise rights and respect for property and person.
- 2. The patient has the right to personal privacy.
- 3. Surgeon Surgery Center & Cimarron Surgery Center must comply with the Department's rules for the privacy and security of individually identifiable health information as specified in Title 45 CFR parts 160 and 164.
- 4. The patients has the right to be fully informed about a treatment or procedure and the expected outcome before it is performed.
- 5. If a patient is adjudged incompetent under applicable State law by a court of proper jurisdiction, the rights of the patient is discussed and exercised by the person appointed under State law to act on the patient's behalf.
- 6. The patient or patient's representative has the right to make informed decisions regarding the patient's care.
- 7. If a State court has not adjudged a patient incompetent, any legal representative designated by the patient in accordance with State law may exercise the patient's rights to the extent allowed by the law.
- 8. Surgeon Surgery Center & Cimarron Surgery Center must inform the patient or patient representative or surrogate of the patient's rights, and must protect and promote the exercise of these rights and post in areas or places in which patient is likely to see.
- 9. Patient rights are available prior to procedure.
- 10. Surgeon Surgery Center & Cimarron Surgery Center provides information regarding Advanced Directive, including a description and is documented in the medical report.
